The new website is feature packed and is a very useful tool for architects, builders, trade applicators and even D.I.Y. handy people. In fact there is four key ways to enter the site from the home page by clicking on the sections: 'Specifiers', 'Trade Applicators', 'Distributors' or 'D.I.Y.'. Each page in a section title keeps a theme colour throughout.

In the 'Specifier' section, with just *four easy steps* you can identify the substrate you want to coat and the product finish you desire. These steps take you to the 'Shieldspec Data Sheet' which even has an on-board coverage calculator to give you how many product packs you need for the job.

The 'Shieldspec Data Sheet' can be printed in landscape orientation for your convenient use. A Shieldcoat Representative will promptly contact you to give assistance in colour choices and pricing.

Film thickness, drying times, re-coat times and other support products are included on the 'Shieldspec Data Sheet'. MSDS safety sheets are available for viewing or printing either from the 'Shieldspec Data Sheet' page or from the menu on the left hand side of most screens.

The site also has 'Product Information Sheets' which give more details about the product you have chosen such as a description, where it can be applied, features, benefits, perhaps a photo of the finish and a brief application guide.

There is also helpful 'Step by Step' features in the Products area on selected products that introduce a simplistic application approach. In the Products page you will also see a Catalogue which highlights most of the products and machines we make or sell.

A first for Shieldcoat is a Case Study page which reveals special jobs that have been done using Shieldcoat products. Products such as Thermobond HRC, Naturatex and Stencilshield are displayed and have been used on larger projects such as Councils, Airline Companies, Water Corporations etc.
